

Moeve's position and strategy on circular waste management

Positioning

Moeve is aware of the enormous potential of the resources contained in waste, and places them as a cornerstone in its Circular Economy Policy. Through the search for sustainable alternatives, it makes possible the reduction in the extraction of new materials, by reintroducing waste generated by third parties or by society in its own facilities, as raw material in its production processes.

In the same way, Moeve works on the design and implementation of cleaner production, through the optimization of its production processes, which allow the maximum use of raw materials, resources and energy, reducing the waste generated, for which it looks for alternatives of valorization, whenever possible.

Strategy

The principles of the Circular Economy are part of the Circular Waste Management strategy.

Thus, in order to achieve the best overall environmental result for the waste it generates, Moeve promotes the application of the Waste Hierarchy and its Management, in the following order of priority:

- **Prevention.** Carrying out measures to reduce both the volume and its hazardousness, by applying the best available techniques and, among others, the acquisition of raw materials in bulk, application of cleaning techniques that minimize the content of chemical agents or water and favor the separation and reprocessing of extracted



products, or carrying out pre-treatment of sludge or process flows that allow the recovery of part of their components.

- **Preparation** for reuse. Through the use of catalysts, resins, oils, fluids, etc. that allow their regeneration for reuse.
- **Recycling.** By segregating waste at source and delivering it to authorized waste managers who make use of its materials for the manufacture of new products, as opposed to those who use landfill as a form of management.
- **Energy recovery.** For those wastes that cannot be recycled and whose calorific value allows their energetic use, prioritizing delivery to authorized managers that can use them as alternative fuel.
- **Disposal.** When the application of the previous forms of management is not possible, delivering the waste in controlled and authorized deposits, after treatment of the same.

For those products that Moeve places directly on the market, it assumes Extended Producer Responsibility, taking charge of the waste generated by its clients, after use, through its adhesion, preferably to Integrated Management Systems, for its collection and recovery.

On the other hand, through an ambitious sustainability plan to lead sustainable energy and mobility, Moeve provides recovery solutions for waste generated by third parties or by society by transforming it into fuels and circular energies, as well as secondary raw materials for other industries.
